1. What are the hours of school?

The student day is 8:35 a.m.- 3:25 p.m. Students can enter the building at 8:20 a.m. Students may also attend FOCUS study tables, beginning at 8:00 a.m.

When the temperatures drop below freezing, the doors will open at 8:00 a.m.

2. When does school start?

We start on Monday, August 3, 2015. Registration will run July 27 and 28 from noon until 7 p.m. Students can get their schedules and lockers at registration.

3. What types of advanced courses are offered?
