

GCJHS FAQs

❑ What are the hours of school?

The student day is 8:35 a.m.- 3:25 p.m. Students can enter the building at 8:20 a.m. Students may also attend FOCUS study tables, beginning at 8:00 a.m. When the temperatures drop below freezing, the doors will open at 8:00 a.m.

❑ When does school start?

We start on Monday, August 2, 2017.

❑ What types of advanced courses are offered?

GCJHS offers Honors and Quest (High Ability) English, advanced math including Algebra and Geometry for high school credit, advanced science including Biology 1 for high school credit, and Spanish 1 for high school credit. There is also a Violin class.

❑ What are the related arts classes?

7th Grade students will have:

- Music in Education (MIE)

- Family and Consumer Sciences (FACS)

8th Grade students will have:

- Wellness
- Technology
- World Languages

❑ How much is textbook rental?

7th grade = \$150.62*

8th grade = \$149.05*

*If your student qualifies for assistance, you pay consumables fee of \$33.00

❑ Does GCJHS offer MacBook insurance?

Yes, you can purchase insurance through the school. The initial cost is \$50 and the deductible is \$40 per incident. For more specifics, please contact the office.

❑ What forms of payment can I use to pay textbook rental and other school fees?

❑ How much are athletic fees?

Each athlete is required to pay a one-time transportation fee of \$50 per school year. Additionally, a participation fee of \$50 is charged per sport.

❑ How do I check my child's grades?

[PowerSchool](#) is where all student grades, schedules, and attendance are maintained. You can sign up for a PowerSchool account by clicking the link above. The Greenfield-Central district code is JJRP.

Students automatically have a PowerSchool account once they are enrolled in the school system. They simply need to login with their school ID and password.

❑ How do I update my child's contact information?
