Recently, your child participated in the fall NWEA assessment. This is the formative assessment Greenfield-Central Community School Corporation is now using with students in grades 2-8 to check for understanding related to grade level standards in Reading, Language Usage and Math. You will be able to view your child's NWEA Student Progress Report in the PowerSchool Parent portal, under *Student Progress Center* on the left side of the screen. This opportunity will become available beginning on Monday, November 9.

NWEA uses a RIT (scale) score to report a student's current instructional level in Reading, Language Usage and Math. By comparing your child's RIT score in each area to the Greenfield-Central (District) mean RIT score and the national (Norm Grade Level) mean RIT score in that area you can see if your child is *at*, *above*, or *below* level in each area, as measured on this assessment. The RIT projection shows what level your child is expected to reach by the end of the current school year, in each content area.
