

Due to IHSAA/health department guidelines, Greenfield Central Jr. High has made adjustments to the seating capacity and logistics for our home athletic events. Please read through the information below pertaining to each of our fall sports.

Masks must be worn on the campus of Greenfield Central Jr. High, except when a person is eating or drinking. Social distancing should also be observed while waiting at the ticket lines, concession stand, and restrooms.

For football, soccer, and volleyball games, GCJH students are only allowed to attend if they are the sibling of an athlete competing in that event (or cheerleader for football) and if they are accompanied by an adult.

### **Football -- limited to 250 spectators**

Tickets are sold on a first come, first serve basis. When the 250-person capacity is reached, additional spectators/families will regretfully be turned away.

Priority will be given to parents/family of Greenfield Central football players and cheerleaders. Coaches will provide a form to these parents that allows them to let the school know whether they expect to attend each game. Submitting this information does not guarantee a ticket. It simply helps us plan how many tickets we can expect to offer the visiting school. At the event, tickets will be sold on a first come, first serve basis. Students of Greenfield Central Jr. High may only attend if they are the sibling of a football player or cheerleader and are accompanied by a parent.

The bleachers will be the primary seating area for spectators. Gold tape has been placed across the bleachers every 6 feet (side to side). This designates an area where a family unit can sit. Bright yellow tape has been wrapped around the rows of bleachers that are unavailable for seating. This achieves 6 feet of distance in each direction. If only two people sit at each spot, 178 spectators can sit in the bleachers. Knowing that many family units could include more than 2 people, please keep in mind that this will reduce the overall capacity in the bleachers. Each family unit should be 6 feet away from the next family unit in all directions. Handicap accessible seating is available on the first row of bleachers.

Additional seating is marked with gold tape along the fence line at the north and south ends of the bleachers. Utilizing these areas allows us to reach an overall football spectator capacity of 250 people. To plan ahead, families may want to bring a lawn chair if they end up needing to sit in the overflow areas. Again, each family unit should be 6 feet away from the next. At the north end, this area follows the curve around the track, but the sidewalk needs to remain clear. Seating should be in the grass.

Admission is \$4/person for 1st grade and up (each person who enters the facility counts toward the capacity of 250).

**Volleyball -- limited to 175 spectators**

Tickets are sold on a first come, first serve basis. When the capacity is reached, additional spectators/families will regretfully be turned away.

Priority will be given to parents/family of Greenfield Central volleyball players. Coaches will provide a form to these parents that allows them to let the school know whether they expect to attend each game. Submitting this information does not guarantee a ticket. It simply helps us plan how many tickets we can expect to offer the visiting school. At the event, tickets will be sold on a first come, first serve basis. Students of Greenfield Central Jr. High may only attend if they are the sibling of a volleyball player and are accompanied by a parent.

The bleachers will be the only seating area for spectators. Gold tape has been placed across the bleachers every 6 feet (side to side). This designates an area where a "family unit" can sit. Each family unit should be 6 feet away from the next family unit in all directions. Handicap accessible seating is available on the first row of bleachers.

Admission is \$4/person for 1st grade and up (each person who enters the facility counts toward the capacity of 175).

### **Soccer -- limited to 250 spectators**

Tickets are sold on a first come, first serve basis. When the 250-person capacity is reached, additional spectators/families will regretfully be turned away.

Priority will be given to parents/family of Greenfield Central soccer players. Coaches will provide a form to these parents that allows them to let the school know whether they expect to attend each game. Submitting this information does not guarantee a ticket. It simply helps us plan how many tickets we can expect to offer the visiting school. At the event, tickets will be sold on a first come, first serve basis. Students of Greenfield Central Jr. High may only attend if they are the sibling of a football player or cheerleader and are accompanied by a parent.

The bleachers will be the primary seating area for spectators. Gold tape has been placed across the bleachers every 6 feet (side to side). This designates an area where a family unit can sit. At the north end, this area follows the curve around the track, but the sidewalk needs to remain clear. Seating should be in the grass.

Concessions will be available -- drinks, candy, popcorn, and a limited number of breadsticks. Admission is \$4/person for 1st grade and up (each person who enters the facility counts toward the capacity of 250).

## **Tennis**

- No admission charge for tennis. Concessions are not available.
- Restrooms are available by entering Door #1
- Spectators should sit as separate “family units,” with 6 feet of distance between family units in all directions. There are areas to sit on the North and South side of the tennis courts.
- Each player should have his/her individual water bottle. No refilling stations are available at the tennis courts.
- Players should avoid touching the gate/fence when entering the courts. Pre-match introductions will be done by calling names only.
- After playing, players should exit the courts immediately. Players should wash their hands/use hand sanitizer.
- When a player has finished his/her match, they may leave the campus with their parent (with permission from the coach). If staying on campus, players must wear masks and maintain 6 feet of distance from other players and spectators (no congregating as a team unless all are 6 feet apart)

## **Cross Country**

- Masks are required at all times on the GCJH campus, except when engaged in physical activity
- No admission charge for cross country. Concessions are not available.
- Restrooms are available at the brick building by the football/baseball fields or by entering Door #1
- Spectators should watch the race as separate “family units.” At all times, family units should maintain 6 feet of distance from the next family.
- Spectators will not be allowed to congregate at the start/finish line area
